Freedom Conference FAQs

How much does it cost for me to attend?

The cost of the conference is \$65 per person. This includes two meals on Saturday as well as other Conference materials.

Will there be any extra fees, or does my registration cover everything like meals and snacks?

Meals are included in your registration fee, so you will not need to purchase any food. Meals include breakfast and lunch on Saturday.

Can I register on-site?

To ensure your seat at the conference, you will want to pre-register. If seats are still available you may register on-site at the Information Center. Cash, Checks, Visa, Amex, and Mastercard will be accepted.

Will childcare be provided?

Childcare is not provided. It is our hope to create a distraction-free environment for you and we will not be prepared to accommodate children or infants.

What is the attire for the conference?

The attire is casual. You may want to bring a sweater or light jacket if you get cold easily.

What should I bring?

You can come just as you are! But we do encourage you to bring a Bible, a notebook, and a pen.

What sanitization measures will be in place?

Our team will frequently disinfect surfaces throughout the building, and we will sanitize the worship center each day. Hand-sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building. Water fountains will not be available at this time, however water bottles will be provided.

Face coverings are optional. We encourage you to bring a face mask if you plan to wear one. Our teams will be equipped with masks to provide safety and comfort where needed.
